- Drinking containers filled with water are the beverage allowed in the rehearsal area. I will consume food items only in the designated facilities during breaks and lunch time.
- I will not wear hats. This shows respect for our beautiful facilities, our guest conductor and staff, as well as the privilege of being selected to this prestigious honor choir program.
- As a guest, I will respect and personally help care for all of the rehearsal and performance facilities throughout the day.
- I will be responsible for rehearsing and preparing the music to the best of my ability, and will strive to give 100% of my talent and ability to make my honor choir experience successful.
