



ACDA-MN Honor Choir Covid Policy

Covid-19 Mitigation Protocols

During this ongoing, challenging, and ever-changing Covid-19 environment, the goal of ACDA-MN remains to provide a safe and comfortable atmosphere for our student singers, guest conductors, staff, and concert patrons attending a state honor choir event.

- **MASKS:** To be compliant with the resident Covid-19 protocols at our host sites, honor choir students, staff, and audience members are advised that masks are **required** at all honor choir events, including rehearsals and concert performance.
- **SOCIAL DISTANCING:** Every attempt will be made to create safe spaces within our host venues to rehearse and perform. Honor choirs have been reduced in size in 2022 to accommodate this important goal.
- **UPDATED POLICY: VACCINATIONS & COVID TESTING: ACDA-MN now will require that students, staff, and audience members show proof of being fully vaccinated or show proof of a negative Covid-19 test no more than 48 hours prior to the event. Either Antigen or PCR tests will be accepted. If using an at-home antigen test, a time-stamped photo of the test result is required.**
- **COVID SYMPTOMS:** If students, staff, and audience members experience Covid symptoms or test positive for Covid-19, they must stay home and not attend any scheduled honor choir events. Impacted students will receive full refunds.

Please note that this policy and the concurrent policies and guidelines of the CDC, state, city, and local performance venues may add new mandates. All participants should expect to continuously monitor this information as honor choir day approaches.
